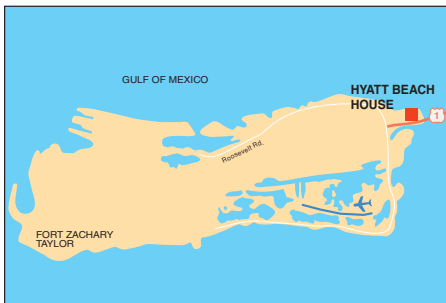




## HYATT BEACH HOUSE

### DIRECTIONS

**From Key West International Airport:** Upon leaving the airport on Airport Road, turn left onto Roosevelt Boulevard. Continue to the second traffic signal, taking the right fork in the road. Immediately move to the left lane to use the left turn lane for the resort entrance.

**From Miami International Airport:** Exit the airport on 21st Street and bear right on the ramp to LeJeune Road/42nd Avenue/SR-953. Go about a half mile and turn right onto 12th St. Go about a half mile and enter the ramp to westbound SR-836/Dolphin Expressway. Go about 3 miles and exit via ramp to SR-826. Continue 3 miles to SR-874/Don Shula Expressway. Go 7 miles to southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR-821. Continue 17 miles to southbound SR-821 exit at Homestead. Go 300 feet to US 1/SR-5. Take US 1 approximately 124 miles to Key West. Once in Key West, continue through two traffic signals and over the Cow Key Bridge. The resort entrance is the first right turn beyond the bridge.

### RESORT HIGHLIGHTS

Located on the northeastern corner of the island, Hyatt Beach House's beautifully landscaped grounds and lush, exotic foliage capture the tropical feel of Key West. In addition to luxury accommodations, guests enjoy dramatic sunsets from screen-enclosed, furnished porches located on the western side of each unit.

### GUEST ACCOMMODATIONS

Hyatt Beach House has 74 luxurious units offering spectacular views of lush grounds, a free-form pool or the Gulf of Mexico. All units include two bedrooms and two baths and can accommodate up to six guests. Each features:
