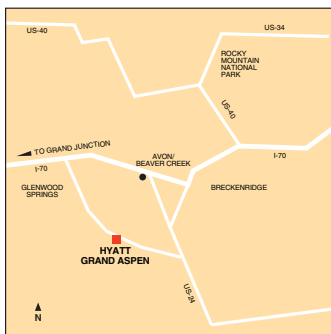

DIRECTIONS

From the east: Access to Aspen is available from the east from Memorial Day through early October via Independence Pass (Highway 82). Upon entering Aspen, turn left at the first stop sign onto Original Street; go one block and turn right onto Durant Avenue; go three blocks and turn left onto Mill Street; take the first left turn at Dean Street and continue to the resort driveway immediately ahead on the right.

From the northwest: Take Interstate 70 to Highway 82 exit at Glenwood Springs; take Highway 82 approximately 35 miles to Aspen; upon entering Aspen, continue three-quarters of a mile on Highway 82 to Aspen Street and turn right; go four blocks and turn left onto Durant Avenue; go three blocks and turn right onto Mill Street; take the first left turn at Dean Street and continue to the resort driveway immediately ahead on the right.

RESORT HIGHLIGHTS
