

DIRECTIONS

From San Francisco Bay Area: Take I-80 W approximately 185 miles to Exit 188B (CA-267, CA-89, Lake Tahoe, Sierraville). Turn right onto CA-267 (Glenn Carlson Memorial Bypass, Truckee Bypass). Continue on CA-267 (Glenn Carlson Memorial Bypass, Truckee Bypass then North Shore Boulevard) approximately 6 miles. Turn right onto Northstar Drive. The resort is 1.3 miles up Northstar Drive then on the right.

From Reno/Tahoe International Airport: Take US-395 N ramp to Exit 68 (I-80, Sacramento, Elko). Follow I-80 W approximately 32 miles to Exit 188 (CA-267, CA-89, Lake Tahoe, Sierraville). Turn left onto CA-89 (CA-267, Glenn Carlson Memorial Bypass, Truckee Bypass). Continue onto CA-267 (Glenn Carlson Memorial Bypass, Truckee Bypass then North Shore Boulevard) approximately 6 miles. Turn right onto Northstar Drive. The resort is 1.3 miles up Northstar Drive then on the right.
