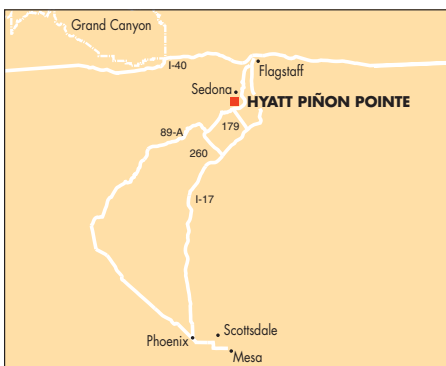




HYATT PIÑON POINTE

DIRECTIONS

From the north: From Salt Lake City, go south on I-15 to US 89 to Flagstaff. After going through the city, take the first exit for Route 89A and go southwest toward Sedona to the Y intersection at Hwy 179. The resort entrance is on the right.

From the south: From Tucson, go northwest on I-10 to Phoenix, then take I-17 north out of Phoenix. Just south of Flagstaff, take the Hwy 179 exit toward Sedona and continue to the Y intersection at 89A.

From the east: From Albuquerque, N.M., go west on I-40. At exit 195 in Flagstaff, go south toward Sedona on 89A to the Y intersection at Hwy 179. The resort entrance is on the right.

From the west: From Los Angeles, follow I-40 into Flagstaff and go south toward Sedona on 89A to the Y intersection at Hwy 179. The resort entrance is on the right.
