DIRECTIONS

From Tampa (North): Take I-75 South toward Naples and merge onto FL-72 via exit 205 toward Siesta Key/Sarasota for roughly 6 miles. Turn left onto Midnight Pass Road/FL-758 and turn right onto Seaside Drive. The resort is on the right.

From Naples (South): Take 1-75 North toward Tampa and take exit 205, SR-72W, toward Siesta Key/Sarasota. Turn left onto Clark Road/FL-72W. Continue roughly 6 miles on Clark Road and turn left onto Midnight Pass Road/FL-758. Turn right onto Seaside Drive. The resort is on the right.
